The NJ Clean Cities Coalition (NJCCC) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization incorporated in the state of New Jersey for the promotion of the development and use of non-petroleum transportation fuels, advanced technology vehicles, and the appropriate related infrastructure. As a designated Coalition within the U.S. Department of Energy’s Clean Cities Program, the NJCCC is one of approximately 90 similar entities across the US, and the only one in New Jersey. Clean Cities strives to advance the nation's and region’s energy security by supporting local decisions to adopt practices that contribute to the reduction of petroleum consumption. The Clean Cities network of coalitions support the development of public/private partnerships to promote alternative fuels and advanced vehicles, fuel blends, fuel economy, hybrid vehicles, and idle reduction. The NJCCC is proud to have been nominated as the DOE’s “Coalition of the Year” for 2010.

The NJCCC sponsors a membership coalition for the benefit of its stakeholders. The coalition’s activities include training sessions, technical events, fleet manager workshops, public outreach, and media campaigns. The most up-to-date information on funding opportunities & incentives, legislation & regulations, Alternative Fuel Vehicle technologies and availability, infrastructure development, safety, and other relevant topics are discussed at our meetings and in our publications.
